Age limit: Upper age limit is 28 years, relaxable for SC/ST/OBC persons as per Govt of India rules.

It may be noted that no TA/DA will be paid for attending the interview. There is no provision for Hostel facility at National Institute of Pathology. All candidates must bring 10th class certificate as proof of age and caste certificate to avail age relaxation.
